**TRIP ITINERARY**  
**Toolangi Trek.**

- Date:** Sunday, 4th June, 2006.  
**Trip leaders:** Alan & Lorna Downing.  
**Trip Grading:** Easy.  
Note that this grading is assumes no rainfall in the week leading up to the Excursion
- Equipment:** Spares; Top & Bottom radiator hoses; Heater hoses (or the ability to block off heater delivery and return flows); Fuses; Ancilliaries belt.
- Recovery Gear;** Basic recovery gear, Snatch Strap & Bow shackles (unlikely these will be required)  
**Communications;** UHF CB Channel 10 initially.  
**Safety;** Fire extinguisher and First Aid Kit.  
**General;** Compressor, Puncture Repair kit (if you possess them)
- Maps:** Rooftop Toolangi – Black Range Forest Activities Map for an overview. Fire map 8022-4-4 Monda & 8023-3-3 Klondyke for detail
- Convoy limit:** 8 vehicles maximum. First come first served basis
- Fuel:** ¾ tank minimum ex Toolangi.
- Departure Time:** 10:00 am.

## **Preamble**

This excursion is a low risk social activity that uses roads suitable for 2WD vehicles if care is taken. It is unlikely that any danger will be encountered unless there has been a lot of rain in the week leading into the activity. We will visit the Sculpture Trail/Yea River Walk (adjacent to the Discovery Centre), the Wirrawilla Rainforest Walk (Sylvia Creek Road), Murrindindi Cascades and Wilhemina Falls (both accessed from Murrindindi Road).

Participants should equip themselves with comfortable footwear as there will be about 6 km of walking involved.

The whole area is a temperate rainforest with many species of plants and animals. If participants are careful to make little noise many of the animals may be sighted. It is also an active logging area, which is why a Sunday has been chosen for the activity, as it will provide the best possibility of not meeting logging trucks.

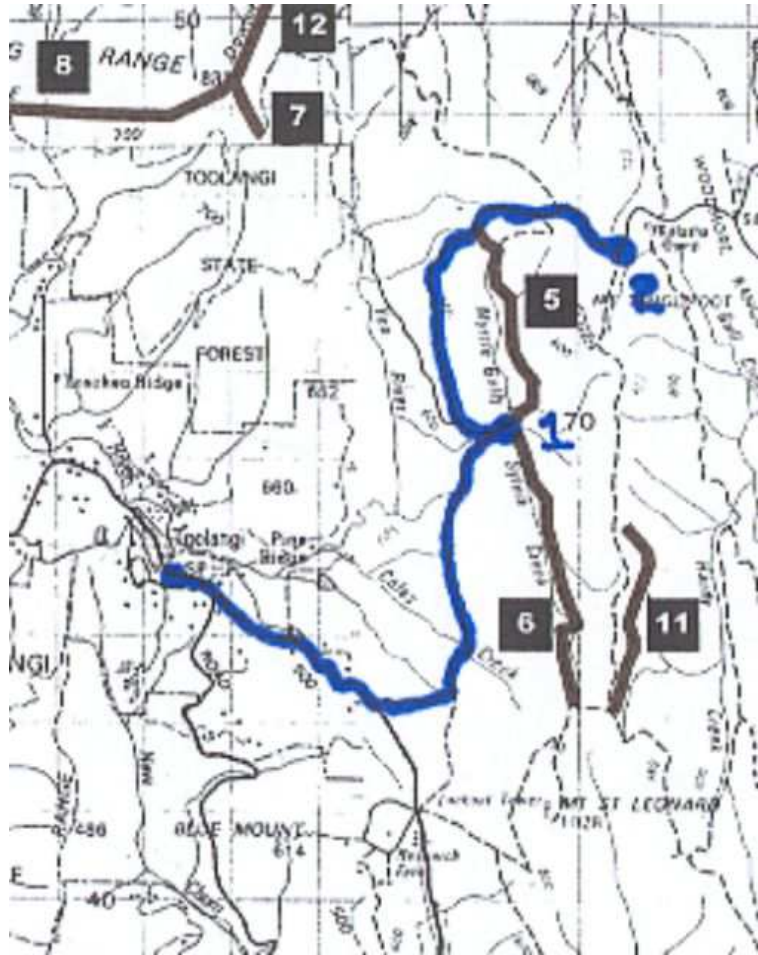

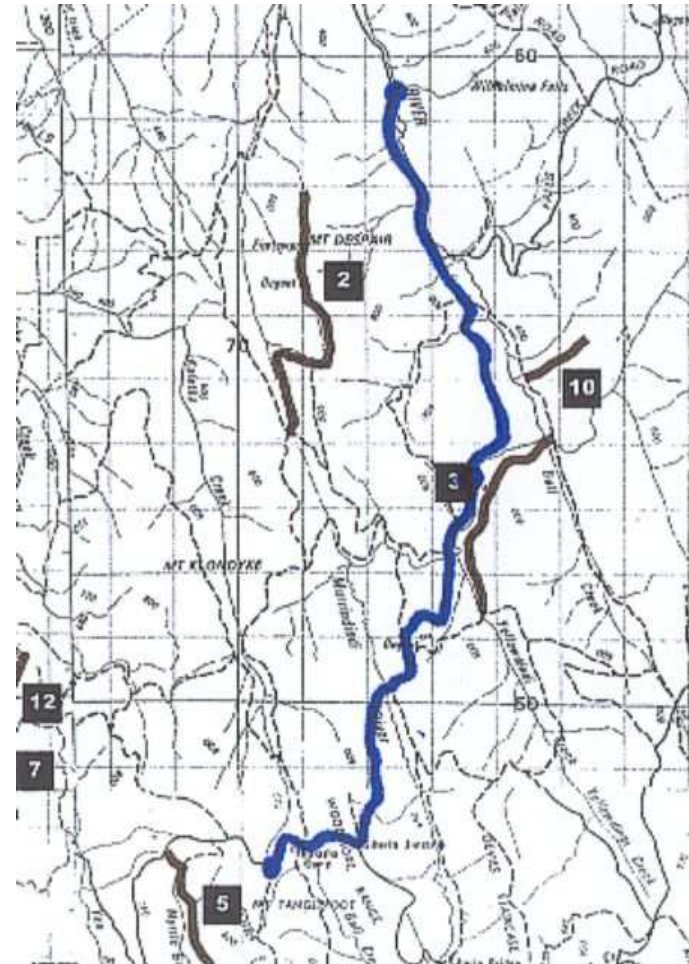
